

# Coronavirus: visitor agreement

---

Please read the statements below.

Our school will welcome visitors if:

- The visitor is not at risk of bringing coronavirus into the school

You should not come into school if you currently need to self-isolate, according to the [latest government guidance](#), for example if you:

- Are displaying any coronavirus **symptoms** (a new continuous **cough**, a high **temperature**, or a **loss or change in their sense** of taste and/or smell)
- Have **travelled from or through a country that is not exempt** from the 'all but essential' travel guidance in the last 14 days
- Have been in **contact with someone who has tested positive** for coronavirus

- The visit is essential

For example visitors who are essential to the health, wellbeing and safety of pupils, visitors who need to cover lessons or visitors who are carrying out urgent maintenance

- The visitor follows the measures the school is taking to minimise the spread of coronavirus, these are:
  - **Washing hands** thoroughly and regularly with soap and water for 20 seconds
  - Where possible, maintaining a **distance of 2 metres** from everyone else in the school. No handshaking or other physical contact between visitors and the school community
  - Providing **contact details** to the school, in case the school needs to contact you following public health advice in the event of a coronavirus outbreak within the school community

- **I confirm that I do not currently need to self-isolate, in accordance with the latest government guidance**
- **I will follow the school's hygiene practices (set out in the section above)**
- **Should I experience coronavirus symptoms within 48 hours after leaving the school, I will notify the school. I will take a coronavirus test and notify the school of the result.**
